



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

KPMG'S INTERNATIONAL CASE COMPETITION 2018 (the "Competition")

1. To enter the Competition, four persons (a "Team") who are each aged 18 or over and students (either undergraduate or postgraduates) and studying at a UK University must submit an entry application via the [website](#) no later than the closing date as stated on the competition web page (the "Closing Date"). The Team must consist of 2 female and male participants.
2. All four team members MUST meet KPMG's minimum academic requirements to be able to submit an application. Standard entry requirements can be found by clicking [here](#).
3. Each Team's application will be assessed by KPMG LLP ("KPMG") after the closing date and successful Teams will be notified that they have been selected to participate in the next stage of the competition ("Stage Two") in December 2017.
4. Each Team's application must be submitted in accordance with these terms and conditions on or before the Closing Date to be entered into the Competition. An individual who forms part of one Team may not form part of another Team. Late Entries; multiple entries made by one Team; and Entries made by a Team that contains a participant who is also a member of another Team will not be accepted.
5. Stage Three will take place in January 2018 and all four team members MUST attend to qualify for a place in the UK Final.
6. Travel to Stage Three will be borne by the Team members personally. KPMG will reimburse the reasonable travel costs incurred as a result of attendance at Stage Three up to a maximum of £50 per individual Team member, subject to the provision of valid receipts.
7. Stage Three will be judged by KPMG and the winning Teams will be notified accordingly. KPMG's decision is final and binding. No correspondence will be entered into.
8. The Team that wins the UK Final shall attend the International Competition Final in Kuala Lumpur on 9 – 12 April 2018 (the "International Final") as the UK representative. Return travel to the International Final in Kuala Lumpur from a UK airport along with accommodation in Kuala Lumpur during the International Final shall be arranged by and paid for by KPMG LLP ("KPMG") for the winning Team members only. In addition, breakfast, lunch and dinner shall also be provided by and paid for by KPMG for the winning Team members only. The winning Team members should arrange their own travel insurance independently. KPMG will not provide any travel insurance for the winning Team members. All Team members must be available to travel to Kuala Lumpur on the 8th April 2018 to return on 13th April 2018. Additional nights in Kuala Lumpur must be borne by individual team members personally and arranged in advance with KPMG LLP at their discretion.
9. KPMG will endeavour to arrange visas for any students who require them to travel to the International Final in Kuala Lumpur. KPMG will not be held responsible for delays in processing visas which could lead to team members being unable to attend the International Final. By agreeing to these terms and conditions you are complying with this condition.
10. By entering this Competition:
 - a) You agree to these terms and conditions;
 - b) All Team members must confirm they will be available for all Competition dates; and
 - c) All members of each Team MUST meet the KPMG graduate recruitment entry requirements which can be accessed by clicking [here](#).
